

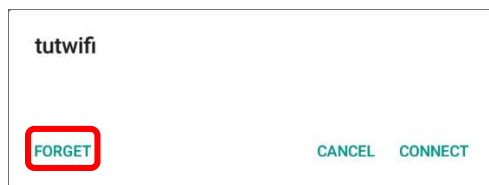
How to reconnect tutwifi – For Android user

This document describes the procedure to reconnect tutwifi after changing password on Android devices.

Setup Procedure

1. Press the menu button on the home screen and select "Settings", then "Wireless setting" and to "Wi-Fi setting". Select "tutwifi" from the displayed SSID list.
2. Tap "FORGET" on the "tutwifi" screen.



3. Again, select "tutwifi" from the displayed SSID list on the "Wi-Fi setting".
4. Reconfigure as follows on the setting screen of the authentication method:

EAP method: TTLS

Phase 2 authentication: MSCHAPV2

CA certificate: unspecified

Identity: your username of information systems and the network of Toyohashi University of Technology

Anonymous identity: Blank

Password: your password of information systems and the network of Toyohashi University of Technology
